

## Events & Activities Recap of the Past Year

In September 2008, the Foundation for Annie Jeffrey kicked off its annual campaign. Annie Jeffrey Health Center needed funding for numerous Wish List items. The campaign raised over \$55,000 to help fund phase II of the building project, purchase new medical equipment and fund the Healing Garden. The Foundation purchased a Bili Light phototherapy lamp and a surgical supply cart with funds raised from this campaign. The Foundation also approved the purchase of a treadmill for the wellness center.

The Foundation Family Tree Celebration was held on the first Sunday in December and raised over \$1,000 to help purchase an ice and water dispenser for patients and their families. This annual event allows community members to purchase ornaments to hang on a Christmas tree at the hospital to remember and honor loved ones.

On December 7th Annie Jeffrey Health Center dedicated the new Healing Garden. Dr. Jameson spoke at the dedication as a tribute to his father and the influence that he had on his life.

Also, on December 7, 2008, Annie Jeffrey Health Center dedicated their Donor Wall with a program and reception.

In May, the Foundation for Annie Jeffrey approved the purchase of a new treadmill for the Cardiac Rehab/Wellness Center at Annie Jeffrey Health Center. The Center's utilization has grown over the years and is now seeing more than 8000 visits annually.

The Foundation also assisted the Volunteers in the purchase of a baby warmer for the obstetrical department.

In June, fifty-six golfers from area hospitals and local businesses participated in the first annual Foundation for Annie Jeffrey golf tournament at Ryan Hills Country Club. Proceeds from this event will be used to purchase a new EKG machine at Annie Jeffrey Health Center.

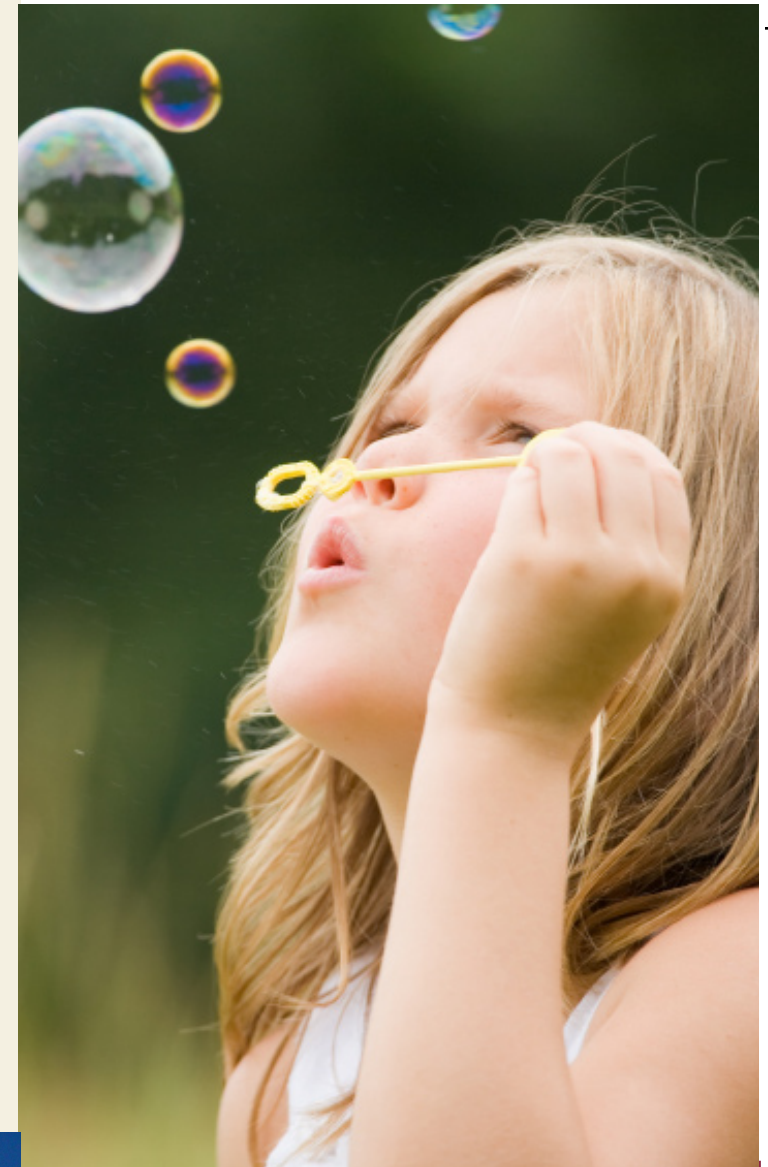
