- The marathon will begin January 1, 2012. Participants have 8 weeks to complete 26.2 miles. Participants track their own miles and submit them each week - by email or in person.
- Weekly prizes will be given to reward participants for meeting specific goals.
- To keep you on track and motivated, we will have exciting weekly contests and drawings where everyone can win prizes!

The threat of carbon monoxide poisoning grows as the weather turns colder, and the use of furnaces, fireplaces, car engines and generators in poorly ventilated areas can lead to carbon monoxide exposure.

Carbon monoxide is a colorless, tasteless and odorless gas that can affect the flow of oxygen in the blood stream. Poisoning can take hours to days. Signs include headache, dizziness and flu-like symptoms. Those who are exposed need to go to their health care provider or hospital to receive immediate treatment.

Women Say Mammograms Give Them a Sense of Control

N arly 90% of U. S. women believe mammograms are vital to their health and well-being, according to a new survey sponsored by the American College of Radiology. The research also revealed that by having routine mammograms, women gain a sense of control over their own health care.

The death rate for breast cancer has dropped by more than 30% since 1990 with the help of mammography.

Although many medical organizations recommend that all women over 40 get yearly mammograms, the number of U. S. mammography facilities is on the decline. According to the U. S. Food and Drug



Administration figures, there are currently 223 fewer mammography facilities and 1331 fewer mammography scanners in the U. S. than there were in 2007.
